Simulation in paediatric burns

Emergency burn care requires both medical knowledge and non-technical skills.

The majority of adverse events in health care are associated with non-technical skills, such as poor leadership, inadequate teamwork, lack of coordination, and ineffective communication.

These skills can be learned by training on Crisis Resource Management (CRM) principles through Simulation. The aim of the workshop is to give an insight on non-technical skills putting theory into practice through simulation using paediatric burns case scenarios. The coursework environment will be conducive to learning, friendly, non-judgemental, and welcoming.
