The Manchester Burns course offers a specially designed programme of study at Degree level 6 and Masters level 7. It is run by experts working in burn care who provide in depth knowledge and experience of adult and paediatric burn injury.

The Manchester Burns Course is suitable for all multi disciplinary professionals who work within the field of burn injury management. Study days will be held at either: Wythenshawe Hospital, or Royal Manchester Children's Hospital, Manchester University Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust. The awarding institution is Manchester Metropolitan University.

A Certificate in Professional Studies (Burns Care) or a Post Graduate Certificate (Burns Care) is awarded on the completion of the Core Unit and one Elective Unit. Each unit can also be accessed as a stand alone unit.
