He undertook ground-breaking research in laser surgery and skin replacement.

He was a committed teacher and trainer and was a much-loved Training Programme Director for the London Deanery for many years where he supervised the training of many young plastic surgeons.

He studied medicine as an undergraduate at both Oxford and Cambridge and achieved the unique distinction of being awarded a rowing Blue by both universities. He was also a very keen swimmer, cyclist, marathon runner and ironman triathlete.

He leaves behind his beloved wife, three children and grandson.
